Summary of Stakeholder Questions/Comments Regarding Sacramento County Communitywide CAP Project and Process

Stakeholder Questions and Concerns

- ▲ Why burn methane at the landfill?
- ▲ Can our building materials be more locally sourced?
- ▲ We are not taking into account human extinction
- ▲ Concern about future economy due to climate change
- ▲ Climate change affects most vulnerable and least resourced communities, those at a disadvantage
- ▲ Can SMUD include information about CO₂ emissions on individual utility bills based on kilowatt hours (kWh) used?
- ▲ SMUD should provide more information on Greenergy program and how individuals can contribute
- ▲ How does the currently proposed transportation tax bill (Measure B) relate to the CAP and its goals and policies? Transportation tax is unfair because there are currently no good public transportation options in the County.
- ▲ Understand best and worst (such as Elk Grove) practices and learn from them
- ▲ Who will monitor the CAP, and how?
- ▲ Temperatures are too high

Items for County to Consider for Inclusion in Communitywide CAP

- ▲ Incorporated areas of County
- ▲ Emissions associated with manufacturing, purchasing, and consumption of goods (i.e., consumer goods, manufacturing, shipping, building materials)
- ▲ Cost of health impacts related to climate change (California Department of Public Health tools)
- ▲ Health impact assessment
- ▲ Consider the Living Community Challenge as a CAP measure

- ▲ Work with areas outside Sacramento County with regards to climate adaptation
- ▲ Build closer to transit and jobs
- ▲ Incorporate Environmental Justice Advisory Council recommendations
- ▲ Composting/green waste
- ▲ Address less work days associated with climate change
- ▲ Recycling for County buildings
- ▲ Landscaping at County buildings (model gardens for conservation, food/urban agriculture)
- ▲ County employee schedules/working from home

Comments/Questions on Public Outreach Process

- ▲ More meetings needed in various locations and at various times to accommodate larger population
- ▲ Open Green Team meetings to the public and vet the proposed measures through the Green Team
- ▲ Incorporate public input more
- ▲ Not enough public outreach is being proposed
- ▲ What is the Stakeholders' role in monitoring and evaluation of CAP measures?
