**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors recognizes the Natomas Joint Vision Area, that area generally depicted on Exhibit A (attached), as containing unique environmental and regulatory features; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors recognizes the value of the permanent preservation of open space for habitat, agriculture, or other purposes, and protecting existing and future airport operations, as outlined in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City and County of Sacramento dated December 10, 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors is initiating proceedings, via this resolution, for a Special Planning Area (SPA) zone to facilitate the consideration of regulations that could implement the vision anticipated in the 2002 MOU for the unincorporated portion of the County;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento does hereby initiate proceedings for a Special Planning Area zone.

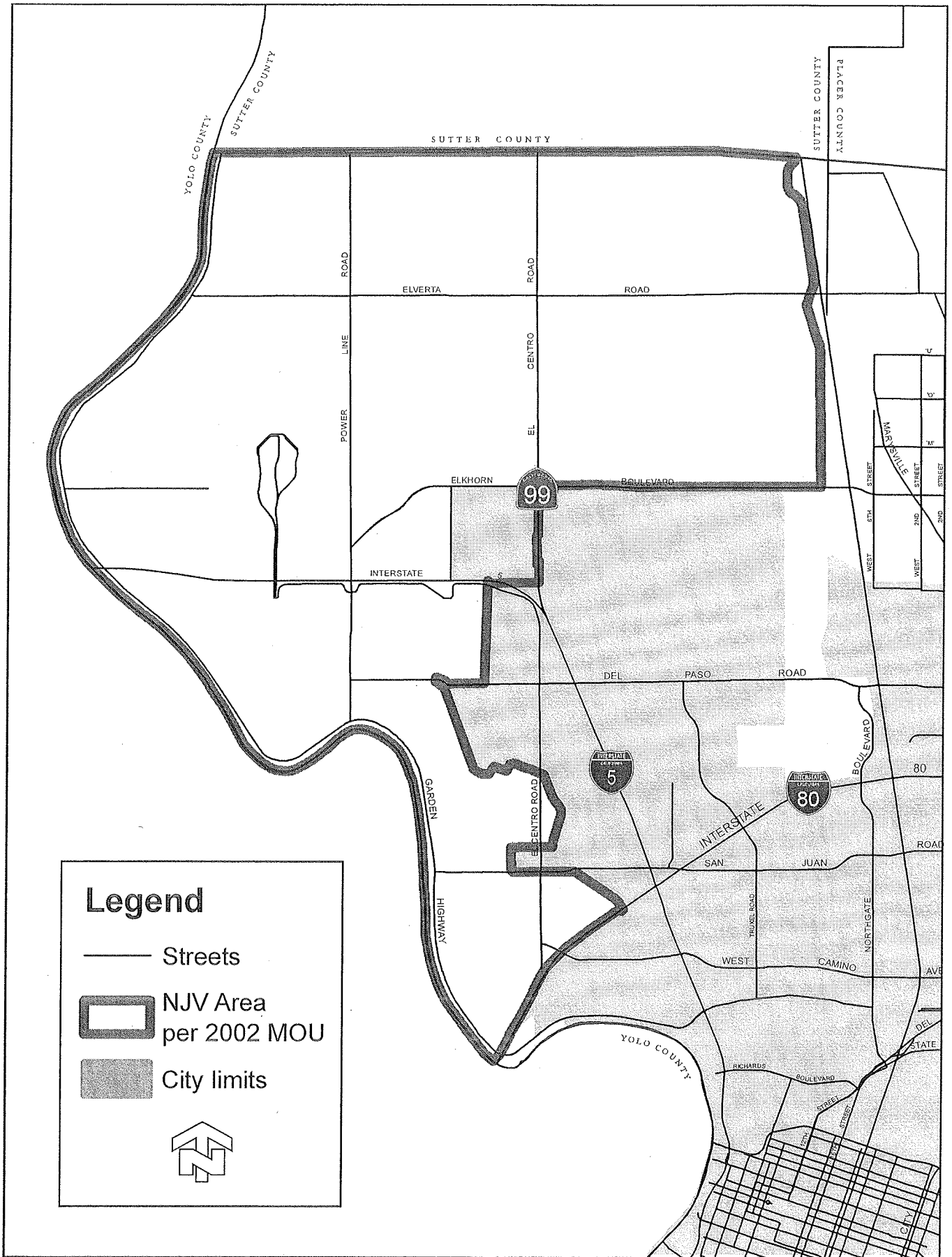
